*ALL ANIMALS **MUST** TO BE CHECKED IN/REGISTERED WITH SHEEP SHOW STAFF BEFORE STALLING.

ANIMALS SIGNED UP IN PUREBRED BREEDING STOCK CLASSES **MUST SHOW PROOF OF PAPERS.

***SCRAPIES TAG IDENTIFICATION SHEET **MUST** BE FILLED OUT AND TURNED IN BEFORE ANIMALS ARE UNLOADED.

****ALL OUT OF STATE ANIMALS **MUST** PRESENT HEALTH PAPERS MEETING WISCONSIN REGULATIONS.
(A copy will need to be handed in at time of check in.)

*******There will also be a Master Stockman contest on Saturday, May 27th.** This contest is only for kids signed up for the breeding show. Divisions will be based on age and are as follows: Beginner (8 and under), Junior (9-11), Intermediate (12-15) and Senior (16-19). The contest will consist of: Judging, a Skill-a-thon, and showmanship. In order to be eligible to be entered in the contest and receive an award, you **MUST** participate in all 3 of the activities. More information as well as times will be given the day of the show. **MAKE SURE AT CHECK IN TIME, YOU TELL THE SUPERINTENDENT THAT YOU WANT TO BE SIGNED UP FOR THE MASTER STOCKMAN CONTEST.**

MARKET LAMB

RULES AN REGULATIONS

1. NSC Memorial Day weekend show is an open lamb show but will be following WCLA rules and regulations.
2. Showmanship classes are open to all youth ages 19 and under as of January 1st, 2017. Showmanship registration will occur at the show(s) and take place after each show(s) on Saturday, May 27th and Sunday, May 28th.
3. Check in time and weigh in is 7am-8:30am Saturday and Sunday.
4. Lambs will be vet checked and blankets **must be** taken off during inspection and weigh-in.
5. Lambs will be allowed to cross the weigh scale **only** once. This weight will be the final weight used for the whole weekend. So if the exhibitor is showing both Saturday and Sunday, they **do not** have to reweigh Sunday morning.
6. Market lambs shown in the market show **cannot** be shown in the breeding stock show.
7. NSC is not liable for any accidents or losses.
8. Payouts for each class will be determined the day of the show and will be based on number of animals in each class.
9. All rules are subject to interpretations by show committee.
10. Any animal showing any signs of contagious disease will be disqualified and asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
11. Pen clean-up is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
12. **Bracing of the animal is allowed however ALL 4 feet of that animal must be on the ground at all times. Slapping of the animal will not be tolerated.**
13. Pens are available on a first come first serve basis. Bedding will not be supplied or available to purchase.
14. Pre-entries are due postmarked on or before May 19th and are non-refundable.

BREEDING STOCK

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. NSC Memorial Day weekend show is an open lamb show.
2. Lambs will be vet checked and blankets **must be** taken off during inspection.
3. Lambs **cannot** cross over shows; i.e. market lambs **cannot** be shown in the breeding stock show.
4. Check in time is 7am-8:30am Saturday.
5. Lambs are to be shown in their current age class.
 - Lamb base dates - The age classification for all lambs shall be reckoned as follows:
 - January Lambs – born in January 2017
 - February Lambs – born in February 2017
 - March Lambs – born on or after March 1, 2017
 - Fall Lambs – born September 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016

- Yearlings – born September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016. The age of yearlings may be subject to verification by a veterinarian whose findings shall be final.
6. NSC is not liable for any accidents or losses.
 7. All rules are subject to interpretations by show committee.
 8. Any animal showing any signs of contagious disease will be disqualified and asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
 9. Pen clean-up is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
 10. Pens are available on a first come first serve basis. Bedding will not be supplied or available to purchase.
 11. Pre-entries are due postmarked on or before May 19th and are non-refundable.

*All animals entered in classes A-E **MUST** have proof of registration papers or the animal will not be eligible to show in those classes.

**If there are 5 or more of one breed at time of show in the A.O.B., the class will be split off into it's own class and judged accordingly.

***At the end of the breeding stock portion of the show there will be an award given for the Over-All Grand Champion Ram and Ewe.
